OSS WARNS THE PUBLIC FROM USE OF FRAUDULENT OHP WEBSITE

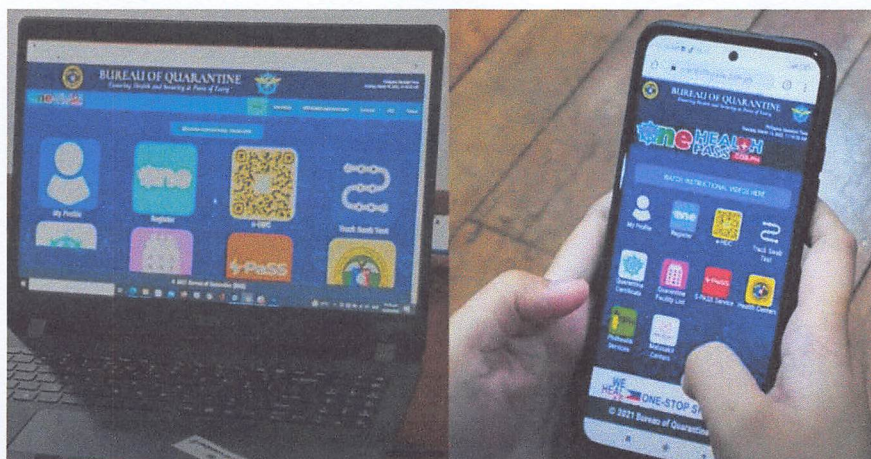
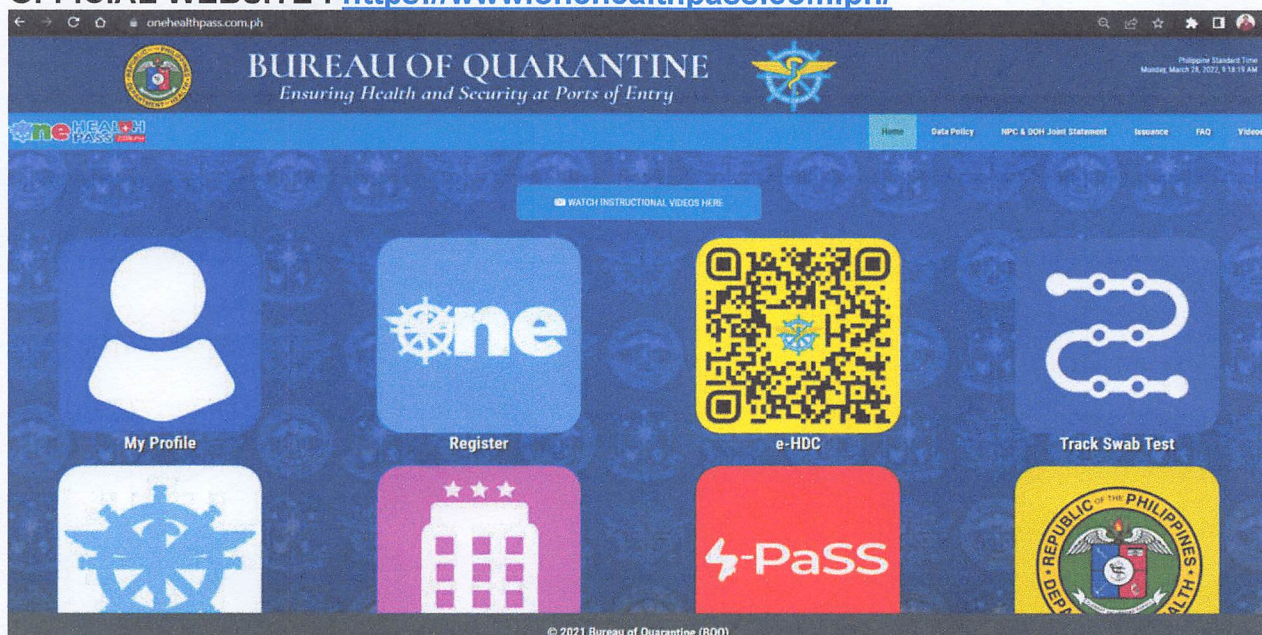
MANILA – In view of the reported creation of a fraudulent website which mimics the official One Health Pass (OHP) website, the One-Stop Shop for the Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (OSS MROF) warns all international arriving passengers seeking entry to the Philippines, to check on the correct URL and only use the official OHP registration portal: <https://www.onehealthpass.com.ph/>.

The OSS MROF likewise reiterates that OHP registration is free-of-charge, and its website interface appears to be like one in the video below:

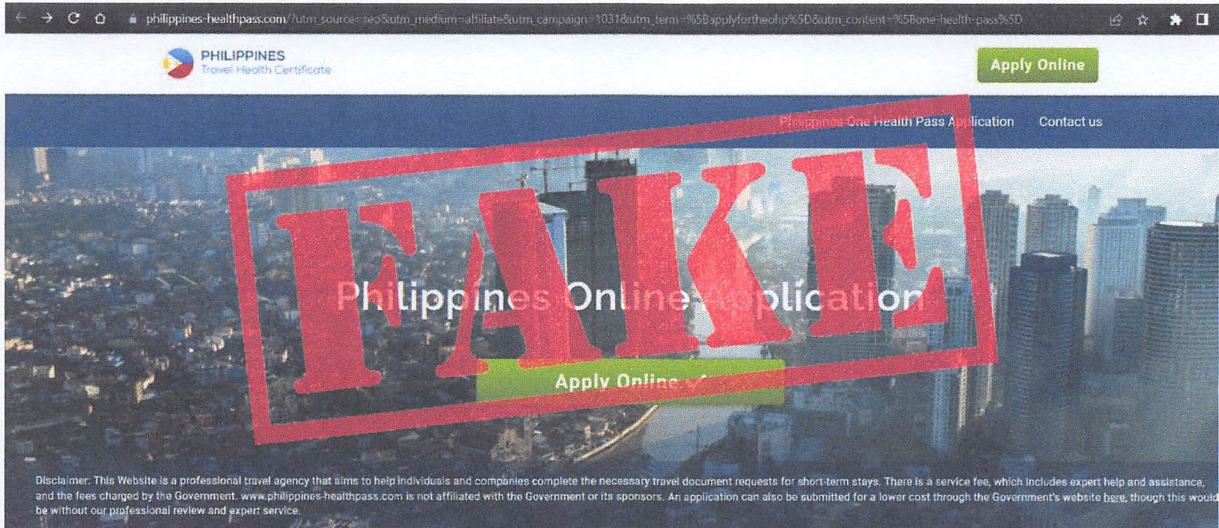
